In his spare time he enjoyed photography, taking pictures at many occasions and community happenings and developed his own pictures. He also played semi-pro baseball for the Monitor Coal Team.

Paul) Moldenhauer, Peter (Rita) and Paul (Wendy); twenty two grandchildren; twenty seven great grandchildren; sister, Stella Peoples.
